Greetings all

During the last couple of months Goldbrook Ventures has seen dramatic changes in its approach to managing the geoscience aspects of our exploration programs. We are moving forward with the very large Raglan project, and as a result there is a need for an expanded and innovative team who can bring new and important skills and experience to the company as we look forward to developing these significant nickel-copper-PGE resources. As President I thought you would appreciate a brief note outlining some of these recent corporate activities.

Just recently we announced that Jamie Pardy, PGeo, has accepted a new position with Goldbrook Ventures as our Exploration Manager for the Raglan project. Jamie was able to join us on the 20th of February and is now reviewing our 2007 program in preparation for the 2008 field season. Jamie will be our main operational and program manager on the ground during the summer field season at Raglan. He will be responsible for overseeing the geoscience program and ensuring all contractors are working efficiently and delivering what we need for a successful program.

Jamie will report directly to the President and Board, and once he's up to speed on our program he will be expected to participate as an important part of the geoscience management team in designing future programs and identifying new opportunities. Jamie has a strong background in the drilling industry having also worked as a general manager of a west coast drilling company and in his earlier years worked as a driller/helper. Jamie is fluent in Spanish, has extensive experience in Peru, and has also worked as a regional geologist for the BC Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources in Prince George for several years where he worked with the mining/exploration industry as well as participated in extensive negotiations with first nations and land use groups.

In addition to a new Exploration Manager we have also expanded our exploration team with the addition of several younger professionals. A new and important addition is geologist, John Bligh who has been hired as our Geoscience Database Manager who will ensure efficient processing and archiving of all corporate exploration information. As well, Sheila Jonnes, a young geologist with experience in copper porphyry exploration in the Cordillera joins us as a Project Geologist to help out with the ongoing exploration at Raglan. We are also very fortunate to have geologists Matt Liard and Gabriella Pang continue to provide us with their expertise and knowledge of the Raglan belt, and assist in carrying out our 2008 program and in training new, temporary field staff for 2008 season.

This rounds off the current expansion of our geoscience team to be able to better and more efficiently cope with such a large project as Raglan and its complex logistical and geoscience information demands. Goldbrook has a unique opportunity to explore and develop the exceptional Ni-Cu-PGE potential of this world-class sulphide-nickel belt and our geoscience team will be moving forward with an aggressive exploration program for the summer and great expectations of yet further successes from our fieldwork.
